- Welcome, (establish a quorum) -- Forty-three (43) lot-owners were represented in person and by Ballots received before the meeting time. The total number of forty-three (43) VEHOA lots-owners represented did not establish a quorum. There were not enough of the membership represented to conduct an official VEHOA Membership Meeting, so NO actions could be taken. The minutes of the last official Annual Membership Meeting, held in January 2020, could not be approved because no quorum of the VEHOA membership was present. Those members present did go on to have an informal unofficial discussion session and participate in the presentations.
